<p>Ellen Friend of Gina's, provides the venue for the party with Frank, Joe, Gina, and Charlie where Frank bullies Charlie</p>	<p>Connie -mildly mentally challenged Friend of Charlie's from Alice's Special Class</p>	<p>Jackie Wellberg The Older of the Wellberg sisters who provide funding for the medical centre, the 'sensible sister'</p>
<p>Mrs Feldman -mature Customer in Bronx Bakery Shop, complains loudly to Mrs Donner</p>	<p>Mrs Nemur -mature Wife of Professor Nemur, upper crust East Side New York, very protective of her husband's career</p>	<p>Adult Norma 20-30 Charlie's long-lost sister who has been caring for their mother who has dementia and with whom he re-connects</p>

<p>Child Charlie -8-10 Interacts with Mother & Father in the recall scenes. Needs to cry & act sick. Calls out "Sick! Sick!" when Mother angry. Acts frightened of tensions</p>	<p>Child Norma- 12-14 Has dialogue. Spoilt child who resents Charlie for the impact on her life. She is teased by her school mates</p>	<p>Teen Charlie 15 Needs to show deep emotions without dialogue, although he does have a few words. He appears as a hallucination to Charlie they have imaginary conversations and teen acts as a mirror to Charlie's emotions</p>
